# Will America Resist An Islamic Future

# **HOST: DAVID WHEATON:**

Will America Resist an Islamic Future? That is a topic we'll discuss today right here on the Christian Worldview Radio Program, where the mission is to sharpen the biblical worldview of Christians and to proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ. I'm David Wheaton, the host. The Christian Worldview is a non-profit, listener-supported radio ministry. It's America's largest and most well-known city. It's the financial center of the country and even the world for free markets. 24 years ago, back in 2001, the most prominent buildings in the city, the World Trade Center crumbled to the ground after Islamists hijacked commercial airplanes and flew them into the buildings causing nearly 3,000 deaths. So how to explain that this city, New York City, just elected a Muslim socialist to be its mayor. Mayor-Elect Zohran Mamdani is not a moderate. He is anti-Israel at his core and he's anti-American. He is a self-identifying member of the Democratic Socialists of America, which opposes traditional American values of limited government, individual liberties, and free markets. In short, Mamdani is the personification of the Red-Green Alliance, the intersectional partnership of Communists and Islamists, with the common goal of toppling America and Christianity.

The left won almost everywhere in the first election since President Trump entered the White House this past January. Virginians voted for a Democrat supermajority in their state, which means they control the governorship in both state houses. Seattle elected a Democrat socialist for mayor, and Minneapolis nearly did as well. In a recent program, we discussed the rise of Islam in Western Europe and how the line may have been crossed for an Islamic future there. But it's the same thing happening in America in places like New York City, Dearborn, Michigan, Minneapolis, and in Texas where a large Islamic development is being proposed Near Dallas.

Alex Newman, Christian author and journalist at Liberty Sentinel Media joins us today on the Christian Worldview to discuss the rise of Islam in America and why it needs to be stopped. He will also discuss other events nationally and abroad, including the rise in political violence on the left and anti-Israel sentiment on the right. Let's get to the first segment of the interview with Alex Newman.

Alex, it's so good to have you back on the Christian Worldview Radio Program. I want to start out today with a quote from Robert Knight. He's a columnist for the Washington Times. He wrote a column after this most recent election earlier November, and he said this, "I don't think blowout is adequate to describe the breadth of the democratic sweep around the country. They won pretty much everything on every ballot." Is that the way you saw this most recent election, Alex? And if so, why do you think it turned out this way considering Trump won a pretty big election in 2024?

### **GUEST: ALEX NEWMAN:**

Well, thank you David. And I think we need to be honest and say yes. The Democrats did very, very well in this election. There's a couple of mitigating factors. Most of the jurisdictions where they won big were already heavily democratic. Even Virginia has been going more and more toward the Democrat Party. As Washington DC grows, as more and more bureaucrats move there from around the country, bureaucrats tend to be far more left-leaning than people who work in the private sector and farmers, truckers, manufacturing workers. So there's that to mitigate it. But the reality is, David, and you and I have talked about this before, as long as our children are being indoctrinated on an industrial scale to support these ideologies, to support these policies, we're going to see more of this. And I submit to people that what we just saw in New York, what we just saw in Minneapolis, what we just saw in Virginia is really just a harbinger of much more to come.

Right now it's in Democrat jurisdictions, but given another generation, we're going to see exactly these same trends even in jurisdictions that right now are considered strongholds of the Republican Party of conservatives. I'm talking about Texas, I'm talking about Florida, I'm talking even about states like Oklahoma, South Carolina, Idaho, Montana. The younger generations are overwhelmingly more liberal. The younger generations are overwhelmingly less likely to be Christian, to support Christian biblical values. And so we're watching now an acceleration of this trend that's been building for several generations. And unless urgent action is taken or God himself intervenes somehow, this is just the beginning.

# **HOST: DAVID WHEATON:**

We're going to talk about your new book later in the program that's coming out in January 2026 with regard to what you just mentioned about the educational system and how it's woke and weaponized. That's the title of your book. We'll get into that a little later in the program. Now I want to ask you specifically about what occurred in New York City with this mayor Zohran Mamdani. As I mentioned, he's only 34 years old, very popular, won the election pretty convincingly there. A lot of people surprised by this that New York would go this direction. Let me play a short soundbite from Mamdani to give the audience an idea of what he sounds like and what he promotes.

# **Audio Sound Bite**

Zohran Mamdani: We are going to freeze the rent for more than 2 million rent stabilized tenants and use every resource at our disposal to build housing for everyone who needs it. We are going to eliminate the fare on every single bus line and make what are currently the slowest buses in the nation move around this city with ease, and we are going to create universal childcare at no cost to parents so New Yorkers can raise their family in the city they love. Together New York, we're going to freeze the...

Crowd: Rent.

Zohran Mamdani: Together New York, we're going to make buses fast and...

Crowd: Free.

Zohran Mamdani: Together New York, we're going to deliver universal...

Crowd: Childcare.

Zohran Mamdani: We will make our city one where every person who calls it home can live a dignified life.

### **HOST: DAVID WHEATON:**

Alex, he's promoting really just socialistic, you could even say communistic type policies for New York City, freeze rent, government owned grocery stores, quote, unquote, "free public transit", quote, unquote, "free" because it's not free, "free childcare." How do you explain Alex, how a socialist, and by the way, he's not part of really the Democrat Party. He's part of the Democratic Socialist Party. And how do you explain how someone like that who is a Muslim, gets elected to be the New York City mayor just 24 years after 9/11 occurred when Islamists flew airplanes into the World Trade Center killing, I think it was over 3,000 people?

## **GUEST: ALEX NEWMAN:**

Well, there's a convergence of factors going on here, David. One is of course, younger generations have been heavily indoctrinated to believe in socialism, to believe in multiculturalism, to reject out of hand biblical values and traditional American heritage as somehow being systematically racist or oppressive in need of tearing down. So the younger generations and the indoctrination are contributing to this in a major way, but there's also several other factors that we can't ignore. New York is one of the most immigrant-heavy cities in the country. Almost 40% of the population of New York City was born in another country. This was by design. It's exactly the same thing we're seeing in the major Western European cities. If you look at the UK now, many of its major cities are run by Muslim mayors, very much including London, the capital city where native Brits are actually in the minority.

If you look at Brussels, native Belgians are literally less than 25% of the population. The vast majority of the city is foreign. Malmo, Sweden, Frankfurt, Amsterdam, the Dutch are in the minority. You see this all across Europe, and we're going to see the same thing in the United States if Donald Trump is unsuccessful and if the momentum turns back into the other direction. And this was all strategic by the way. They thought this through. They planned it for a long time. I've actually spoken with Tom Homan about this publicly, our borders czar, and he articulated a very clear understanding of why the Democrat Party wanted the open border. They understood that the American people, regular normal Americans who've been here for many generations are unlikely to go for the kinds of things that the Democrat Party is selling. And so they just imported a bunch of new voters and they also managed to expand their congressional representation by allowing illegal immigrants to be counted in the census.

So that's one of the big things happening in New York. And then we also have to be clear that there is massive institutional architecture behind candidates like Mamdani. He did not come out of nowhere. In fact, New York City is one of the most extreme examples of this, but the same architecture exists across the country. For many years, I've warned about what I describe as the totalitarian trifecta, that is an alliance of Islamists and globalists and socialists. And I think at first glance, people don't understand why they would be united, why they would have an alliance, because they generally believe pretty different things, at least in

certain important respects. But they do have a common enemy, David, and that enemy is Christianity, the Bible, traditional American society, traditional American civilization, and really Christian civilization.

Back during the first Trump administration, Rich Higgins, who was the director of policy and planning on the National Security Council articulated this very clearly in what became known as the Higgins Memo. He said, there's an alliance, it's global, and it includes Islamists, socialists, communists, and of course the globalists. He described this deep state seeking to become God on Earth, and he said they intend to destroy the United States of America, not just as a nation, but even as an ideal. And if you listen to people on Mamdani's own campaign, they tell you massive Muslim money was involved here. Massive, massive funding was coming from all across the country and the communist architecture, the Communist Party USA, the Democratic Socialists of America, which is in fact a Marxist group, they've been organizing for this for generations, and now their efforts are starting to bear fruit. So this is just the beginning if urgent action is not taken.

### **HOST: DAVID WHEATON:**

Alex Newman is our guest today here on the Christian Worldview, the president of Liberty Sentinel Media. He's also an international journalist, educator, author, speaker, investor, lots of different things. You can find out more with links to him on our website, thechristian review.org.

We recently did a program, Alex, on just what you were talking about, Islam's growth in Europe. And we really focused on what's going on in England. And you have also mentioned that here in Minneapolis, a Somali Muslim socialist almost became the Minneapolis mayor, just like what happened in New York City. You mentioned other states. There's major inroads for Islam going on in Texas. There's something called EPIC City. This is I think about 30 or 40 miles from Dallas. And just to quote Wikipedia, not a super trustworthy source, but just to describe what it is, "EPIC City is a master planned Islamic community centered residential development project in Texas, situated approximately 40 minutes from Dallas near the town of Josephine. The initiative spans 402 acres across unincorporated portions of counties and was initiated by the East Plano Islamic Center." There's where you get the EPIC acronym, East Plano Islamic Center.

Zohran Mamdani has had an intern on his campaign or in his office named Hadika Arzu Malik. And this was from a guy online who posted this named Dr. Maalouf, quoting him, explains in this soundbite that electing Mamdani is part of a holy war and jihad. Let's listen to this soundbite and I will follow up with a question.

# Audio Sound Bite: Hadika Arzu Malik:

And the true believer knows that none of this is in vain, that this is all jihad, that this is all ibadah, and that this is all accounted for by Allah [foreign language 00:12:49]. And so the conversation of doxxing, the conversation of getting arrested and suspended, I think it's time for Muslims to start to say, "All right, so what? Do what you want. I'm going to do what I got to do." Because it's about time to do that.

And I know everybody has their own families and has an education and everything. Just a question. We don't want to get doxxed and we don't want to get suspended and we don't want to get arrested. How gangster are you? That's just my question. How much are you willing to do it? And I know everyone has their own risk

level, but at the end of the day, that's a question to ask ourselves. How committed am I to this? To what extent of my personal material gains am I willing to sacrifice for this bigger noble cause?

I truly believe that when your heart is in the right place, if you get suspended, if you get doxxed, because it's bound to happen when you're doing a righteous cause, and when you're doing something for the sake of Allah here in the west, it will never ever be in vain. And the true believer does not fear that because the true believer knows that the akhira is a promise.

### **HOST: DAVID WHEATON:**

Again, that was an intern for Zohran Mamdani calling out to Muslims saying, "How gangster are you? Everyone has their own risk levels. You have your family, you don't want to get arrested, you don't want to get doxxed, but this is Jihad." What is going on in all these different areas across America from New York to Dearborn, Michigan, down to this EPIC development in Texas, in Minneapolis, here where we live many other places. How was this taking place right under our noses?

# **GUEST: ALEX NEWMAN:**

Well, David, I think there's again several things that work here. The first thing we need to really objectively consider is Islamic theology. This is not a new phenomenon. Going all the way back, more than 1,200 years to the time of Muhammad, Islamic soldiers, Islamic jihadists have been trying to conquer the entire world for their deity, Allah. This is indisputable. They took over North Africa, they took over huge swaths of Central Asia all the way out to Indonesia, northern India, and they did this of course by the sword. They essentially offer people a few different options. You either lose your head or you convert to Islam and confess that Allah is the true deity, and Muhammad is his prophet and messenger, or in some cases they'll allow you a third option. You get to pay a jizya tax and you get to live as a second-class citizen under the boot of your Islamic overlords.

For many centuries, they tried to conquer Europe. In some areas they were successful. They took over the Iberian Peninsula for an extended period. It took a very long time for Catholics to eventually be able to expel them from the Iberian Peninsula. They tried early on in Islamic history to take over France. They were stopped at the Battle of Tours by Charles Martel. They tried to conquer through the other direction. They were stopped at the gates of Vienna in the 1600s when the Polish army came down to help. So this has been a long-term process and your average Westerner has no idea. But the reality is their holy texts command them to do this. They're commanded to fight the infidels wherever they may be found. And their theology articulates the belief that the entire world will eventually come under the control of an Islamic caliphate ruled by an Islamic leader. And basically anybody who gets in the way of that is an enemy of Allah, is an enemy of Islam and must be dealt with.

So we don't want to downplay the influence of Islamic theology. And I believe many of these people, including this young intern who we just heard, are very sincere in their belief that this is truly a holy war that they are fighting against the infidels. But I also think we need to be honest here and recognize that many of these people are being manipulated. They are serving as useful idiots for causes that they don't understand.

And this applies to the communists and to the globalists. So I'll give brief examples of each. The communist world, the Soviet Union actually dispatched thousands of intelligence operatives across the Middle East going back to the '50s and '60s under the leadership of Yuri Andropov for the purpose of radicalizing Muslims and using them as cannon fodder against the Western world, against the United States, against Israel, against Western Europe.

And a lot of this was revealed by Ion Pacepa, who was the head of the Romanian version of the KGB, the KGB's sister agency. And he explains exactly why they did it. They assumed that millions of Muslims would be able to do much more damage to the free Western Christian world than just the communists on their own. And so they tried to harness the power of Islamic extremism to use it as a battering ram against their enemies. The globalists have done exactly the same thing. And we've seen this even recently. If you look for example, at Barack Obama's alliances in the Middle East during his administration, in Libya, he became allied with the Libyan Islamic Fighting Group, which is an actual known al-Qaeda front. The US army knew all about this, and they said so. If you look at a 2012 Defense Intelligence Agency report produced on the leadership of the great general Michael Flynn, they knew that they were supporting al-Qaeda in Syria as they were seeking to overthrow Bashar al-Assad.

And in fact, they say in this intelligence report that one of the objectives of the Western power supporting the revolutionaries who they acknowledged were led by al-Qaeda and the Muslim Brotherhood was the establishment of a Salafist principality in eastern Syria, what eventually became known as the Islamic State. So yes, Islamic theology is a major part of this, but as many Muslims have acknowledged themselves, they've been trying to do this for over a thousand years and they've been unsuccessful because the Christian West was too strong. Now they're laughing because Western governments are importing them into our countries. They're giving them free houses and free food and free so-called education for their children. So this is all very deliberate and it goes back to this alliance that I mentioned that's seeking to destroy the west, destroy the United States, and ultimately destroy Christianity and the church.

# **HOST: DAVID WHEATON:**

This is exactly what is taking place in Minneapolis. There are about 150,000 Muslims in the Minneapolis metro area, mostly from Somalia and eastern Africa. The exert a huge influence here. Liberals and Muslims elected Ilhan Omar to the US house. She's extremely on the left. A Muslim socialist was just nearly defeated in running for mayor of Minneapolis. It's very common to see Somali women in full burkas walking around the suburbs of the Twin Cities. The problem is that Muslims who believe in Sharia law, which they all should if they're a Muslim, that's incompatible with holding to constitutional law in America. This is a major problem here and we'll only get worse over time. So what can be done about this?Alex, I think people listening would say, we have a country that was so influenced by Christianity. We have our Constitution, Bill of Rights, all these things. How to stop this in America? People are going to say, "Well, you can't use a religious test on who comes here as immigrants." What can be done about this to stop what's taking place in Europe? I don't see how that's going to not take place where Islam is going to become dominant in Europe. It already is to a certain extent, but at some point there's a tipping point and I think they're nearing it within the next 10 or 20 years there. How do we stop that from happening in America?

### **GUEST: ALEX NEWMAN:**

That's an excellent question, David, and I agree with your assessment about Europe. Without drastic action, which I think is very unlikely, Europe is going to be islamicized and it's going to be absorbed by totalitarianism, and it may not even be 20 years. You look at many major European cities, Muslims now run them. Muslims with help from the communists and the socialists and the globalists. And we're watching that process accelerate very rapidly through chain migration, through very high birth rates that Westerners stopped having many, many generations ago. So Europe is in major trouble, and I think at this point it's going to take almost a miracle for them to pull out of this. The United States might still be able to stop this process, but it's going to require some actions that people are not going to be very comfortable with. It's going to require large scale deportation.

I think Donald Trump is trying to do this right now, but look at the flak that he's getting. It's going to require major changes to our immigration laws. We already have many millions of Muslims who've been imported under Barack Obama, under Joe Biden. Many of these now are able through chain migration to bring their siblings and their parents and their children, and before you know it, the whole village will be here. We actually saw this happen in Sweden. I was living there shortly before coming back to the United States, was the last country I lived in, and chain migration ended up being a tsunami, right? As soon as one gets there, the whole family comes and then their whole family comes. And very soon you've got far more than originally came in. So it's going to require those things.

And in terms of serving in government, if you go back through our history, what you'll find is our founding fathers almost universally acknowledged that this country was based on Christian principles. Our Constitution actually acknowledges our Lord Jesus Christ. Of course not Allah, not Muhammad, not Buddha, not any of these others. One of the interesting things about our system is that everyone who wants to serve in public offices is required to take an oath to the United States Constitution. And there's a real question about whether true believers in Islam, true believers in the Quran can faithfully take that oath. They have a doctrine called taqiyah where they're allowed to deceive infidels for the advancement of Islam, for the advancement of Allah's cause. But we cannot have people who will not take a legitimate oath to our Constitution serving in our government, especially if their motive is to actually overthrow our system of government. And I believe that's a possible tool that could be used.

But it's going to take some very dramatic action. And I think more importantly than anything, David, it's going to take a revival. Unless Americans turn back to God, unless Americans turn back to Jesus Christ and the Bible, I think America is already being judged and I think the judgment is going to get worse and more severe in the days ahead. And it's interesting because even Martin Luther regarded the Islamic invasions of Europe as a judgment of God for the wickedness that was spreading in Europe. I think that's a very reasonable hypothesis.

# **HOST: DAVID WHEATON:**

Alex Newman is our guest today here on The Christian Worldview, the president of Liberty Sentinel Media. This is an excellent news source you need to get in contact with, and you can find out more about Alex and

his radio program, his podcast, all the things he does at our website. We have a link over directly to his at thechristian rule of you.org. Now, this is slightly off topic from what's going on in America, but it has to do with Islam as well. For people who follow the news, not the mainstream news, but the alternative news media, amazingly, it hasn't been covered in the mainstream news very much at all, is the slaughter of Christians in Nigeria by Muslims. Can you explain just briefly what is taking place there? Who are the Christians being slaughtered and what is going on there?

# **GUEST: ALEX NEWMAN:**

Yeah. So what's happening in Nigeria is what has been happening across Africa literally since the time of Mohammed. If you read the Islamic Holy Text, Mohammed was in a very real sense, a warlord. He believed in expanding the power and the influence of Islam through holy war. And his supporters, his followers are required to do the same things that he did. They are commanded to do that. He is the perfect example and the greatest prophet that ever lived according to Islamic theology. And so throughout the history of Islam, Islamic armies have gone all over the world. They conquered Egypt, they conquered Northern Africa, they conquered, as I mentioned, central Asia, northern India, all the way into East Asia. And they have been trying to conquer Africa basically since the time of Muhammad. And right now the front line of that battle is in Nigeria and various other African states.

We're seeing horrors being perpetrated in Sudan as well. They're going after the Nubians who are largely Christian people, and of course it's the Arabs, the Jihadists who are doing this. And again, this is not new. They have been using Africa to kidnap millions and millions of people who are then enslaved. The only reason that you don't see enormous numbers of Africans across the Arab world is that typically they were castrated and sterilized after being captured and turned into slaves. And so you have something that's been going on for many centuries and what we're seeing in Nigeria is just the latest iteration of this. So you have the Fulani Muslims waging jihad, waging holy war against the Christians of Nigeria. And once they succeed in conquering what's left of the church in Nigeria, they will keep moving southward and they will try to destroy any remnants of Christianity or even paganism, animism, the traditional African religions, witchcraft. It's a process that has been ongoing since the time of Muhammad, and it's a process that will continue unless and until these Islamic armies are stopped or Jesus Christ returns and puts an end to it all.

# **HOST: DAVID WHEATON:**

We're talking a lot about Islamic violence, but earlier you talked about Alex, that there's a confluence. There's a partnership, if you will, between Islam and globalists and socialists. I'm not sure how socialists and globalists are different, but I think they're probably pretty similar. But what we've seen in this country, Alex, recently, is the political violence from the left in this country. You saw just the graphic gruesome assassination of conservative and Christian Charlie Kirk. And then we even saw in this last election the Democrat Attorney General who was running for Attorney General in Virginia, his name was Jay Jones. It was discovered that he had sent text messages where he said he was dreaming about killing, this is a quote, "a former Republican house speaker and his children." No matter, he was still elected to be Attorney General of Virginia.

And then just this week there was a TPUSA event, Charlie Kirk's organization, at University of California Berkeley, very liberal institution out in California and Antifa and leftists, just all kinds of violence trying to shut

down the free exchange of ideas at a TPUSA event. This seems to be increasing, if I'm perceiving this correctly, Alex, it seems like maybe since Trump's in office, they feel like this is their only way to gain power back, to gain influence back. Where do you think things are heading in this country where there just seems to be much more of a willingness to use violence to get your way politically in this country?

# **GUEST: ALEX NEWMAN:**

Well, I believe there is a very real effort being supported by incredibly powerful people and incredibly powerful forces behind the scenes to stir up a civil war in this country. I believe they want Americans shooting each other, they want chaos in the streets, and they've been orchestrating this very deliberately. And there's large amounts of evidence that they've been orchestrating this deliberately for a period of many years. I think from a spiritual perspective, it should be very clear to Christians what's going on here. In Second Timothy, Paul talks about those who have been taken captive by Satan to do his will, forced to run his errands, and that's a very real phenomenon. When Paul calls Satan the God of this world in 2 Corinthians, when 1 John talks about the whole world being in the power of the evil one, I think a lot of Christians just gloss over that and don't like to think about it.

But the reality is we have an enemy. His name is Satan, and he is seeking whom he may devour. He comes to steal, kill, and destroy, and he has blinded the minds of them, which believe not. Jesus imself explained that you're either with Me or against Me. So we see these forces that are very openly hostile to Christ, very openly hostile to God, to the Bible, to the church of Jesus Christ. And we're seeing now an increasing manifestation of this evil. And we're also seeing an increasing willingness to use violence and other illegal means to try to advance this agenda. So I believe there is an effort to collapse the United States, and I believe there is an effort to have Americans turn on each other, to divide us so that we can be conquered. And unfortunately thanks to the open borders, thanks to the revolutionary activity that's been going on in this country, and thanks to the indoctrination of multiple generations of children, they are closer than ever to success.

And I think Christians really need to first of all recognize the danger and do everything possible in a Christ-like manner to prevent that end result. And one of the ways we do that, of course, is by loving our enemies, by praying for those who hate us and persecute us. Another way that we do that is by exposing evil and preaching the gospel, letting people know that they can be redeemed through what Jesus Christ has done on the cross. I think the reason America enjoyed the liberty and the peace and the prosperity and the security for so many centuries is because biblical values predominated because Christianity was so strong in this country. And the more we move away from that, the more everything deteriorates and we basically see what has been the normal human condition in non-Christian societies for most of human history.

### **HOST: DAVID WHEATON:**

What you said is just so important about the values of a society and the importance of evangelism and preaching the gospel and discipleship and strong churches, that's where it all starts and ends. And when that's not in place, then society just falls apart. And I was just thinking about what you said about political violence. I just was reading in Revelation this morning about the two witnesses that proclaim the gospel and immediately preceding Christ's return and how they're killed in Jerusalem and the whole world is celebrating their deaths, they're laying on the streets, weren't buried, just laying there and people are sending gifts to

one another. And it made me think just back to when Charlie Kirk was assassinated, people on the left, not everyone but many videos all over the place of people celebrating this man getting killed and wearing white shirts with blood coming down them to mock the death.

You're right, it is so satanic the mentality here that we're dealing with, the battle between good and evil. It's very, very clear. Alex, you travel a lot internationally. Matter of fact, you've lived a lot of your life outside of the United States, and I know you're going to the Cop30 Climate Conference down in Brazil here very shortly. As you travel as a journalist, what is the mentality of world leaders right now that Donald Trump is in power who's not a globalist, at least according to their liking? Are they just in a mode of waiting him out until someone else gets in power here in America? What is the mentality of world leaders right now?

#### **GUEST: ALEX NEWMAN:**

There's a very small handful, David, who like Donald Trump. There's Javier Milei in Argentina. There is a Victor Orban in Hungary. There's a very small handful. There's a small group of African leaders who actually like Donald Trump. But for the most part, if you look at the communists, the socialists, the Islamists, the tyrants, the various and sundry autocrats who rule so much of the world, there is an incredible loathing of Donald Trump that I think is hard for regular everyday Americans to understand. Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva is a really good example of this. He's the Marxist president of Brazil. A lot of people don't realize how radical he is. He actually with Fidel Castro back in 1990 and the FARC, the Marxist narco terrorists in Colombia and the Sandinistas in Nicaragua, the mass murdering movement there formed the Sao Paulo forum, the Foro de Sao Paulo, which is an international communist network backed by Russia, backed by China dedicated to taking the Western Hemisphere for communism.

And these people hate Donald Trump with such a passion, I don't think it's possible for even Democrats in America to understand. They loathe the guy. And so take the climate summit as a good example. They are in a panic, first of all, because they're worried that Donald Trump may be able to do some permanent damage to their agenda. There's actually big billboards all over Brazil right now. "Don't be bullied by bullies." With big pictures of Donald Trump. And you have Lula, the Brazilian Marxist president standing up to this big bully. They portray him as the top enemy of the world. I was at a climate summit in Poland, I believe a few years ago when Donald Trump was president during his first administration, and there's a taxpayer funded group called the International Climate Action Network. It gets a lot of funding from the Kremlin through a shell company in Bermuda called Klein Limited, the Gazprom, the Russian oil interest fund this, and every year they do these little prizes.

You get the Fossil of the Day Award. And Donald Trump in the United States got first, second, and third place in this competition. And legions of activists, rent-a-mobs, and world leaders and diplomats and fake journalists cheering and celebrating and standing ovations for this. So there's a visceral hatred for Donald Trump, but their big hope is that it'll be like the first administration. He'll do a bunch of damage with his executive orders, he'll leave office, and the next Democrat who comes in will just reverse everything on day one and they'll get right back to where they were. I know there's an appetite in Congress. I've spoken with many members of Congress who do want to enshrine some of this into federal law as of now, and not a lot of it has been enshrined into federal law. And so I think right now they're in a holding pattern, a wait and see.

Hopefully we can get rid of Trump before he does any permanent damage. In the meantime, we'll call him names and portray him as some evil fascist dictator.

### **HOST: DAVID WHEATON:**

Yes, a lot of Christians voted for Trump, and though they may not like his narcissistic personality, they're pleased with what he's doing. Deporting illegal immigrants, working to make cities safer, ending wars, trying to improve the economy through tariffs and energy independence, trying to push back on inflation and also against the woke and transgender agenda. But Trump is temporary. He'll be out of office in just three years. And if this recent election is any indication, the left is primed for revenge. So our hope as Christians cannot be in the President or certain policies, but in God alone and his sovereign plan for the world.

Now, Alex, we've talked about the left Islamist movement that's trying to take over various parts of the world. We haven't talked about the right. It seems to me, and I think many others, that there is a growing sentiment, worldview on the right that is anti-Israel. People will point to people like Candace Owens or Tucker Carlson or some of the pollings suggest that younger Christians, evangelicals are definitely not so supportive of Israel. And again, our position with Israel is that we don't, by supporting Israel, we're not saying that they're good and godly and they always do the right things and they don't do bad things and all that, but we generally believe as a ministry that the Bible calls us to support Israel and the Jewish people because that's who God has promised He will redeem someday. So we want to support their existence and so forth.

So yeah, their enemies of the gospel right now, we understand that, but we're certainly not anti-Israel. Do you see that dynamic taking place on the right people like Nick Fuentes? I'm sure you're very well familiar with him. He's almost like a really anti-Israel. I mean far more than Candace Owens and Tucker Carlson, but what do you make of this situation with the anti-Israel sentiment on the right that's been unusual and what will that mean for the future?

### **GUEST: ALEX NEWMAN:**

Yeah, it is very real, David, and it's been there for a long time. It just hasn't been really acceptable in conservative Republican Christian circles to speak like that until recently. And I think Tucker is actually playing a very important role in normalizing this kind of sentiment, which troubles me greatly. Full disclosure, I think he's done some very important journalistic work over the years, but the recent interview with Nick Fuentes is a very good example of what I'm talking about. This is a guy who has openly called for the death of Jews, who has openly called for the arrest of black people just for being black, who openly says that women like to be raped and beaten, just things that are so profoundly obnoxious and toxic. And yet, from listening to the interview of him with Tucker Carlson, you wouldn't understand that. You wouldn't get that. You'd think he just was pretty regular conservative who maybe just has some slightly unorthodox, maybe a little bit fringy views, and that's very dangerous.

I'm concerned by this. Anti-Semitism has existed historically, and I think there's a reason why. God used the Jewish people to first of all bring Jesus Christ here, right? Second of all, through Moses and the 10 Commandments, to bring the law to humanity. He used His personal nation to be a light unto the other

nations. And in fact, our own constitution was modeled on the ancient Hebrew Republics that we read about in the Old Testament. Many of our founding fathers said so explicitly. I think the real reason for the hatred of Jews is that Jews have been historically God's chosen people. They have been used by God to bring about incredible developments including human liberty. I mean, if you look at the story of Moses, God used Moses and the Hebrews to break the back of the most powerful tyrant in the world and bring us the 10 Commandments, which really is the foundation for individual liberty in Western civilization all the way through to today.

So I'm very concerned by this. I think there's a growing sense that it's not just Israeli policies that we might be critical of. It's not just maybe Benjamin Netanyahu that we have some policy disagreements with. It's that Jews themselves are the enemy, and Jews themselves are behind every bad thing that happens in the world. It's a very, very dangerous trend. I'm encouraged to see Christians speaking out about this, but I also see a very concerted effort to manipulate some younger Christians, some more naive Christians. I just encourage people who might be tempted to fall into these traps, go read Romans 11. God's got a very clear plan for the Jewish people, and as Christians, we are obligated to both understand that and submit to that and support that. This is a really important issue, David, and I'm glad we have the opportunity to talk about it.

# **HOST: DAVID WHEATON:**

Thank you for explaining that, Alex. And Alex Newman's our guest today here on the program from Liberty Sentinel Media. I'm going to ask you a final question about your upcoming book, and we'd like to have you back on to talk about that book in detail when it comes out in January 2026 titled Woke and Weaponized. You can pre-order it now. But before we get to that question on that, you cover a lot of different issues, Alex, on your podcast, and we just highly recommend listeners go and subscribe to your podcast that you do every day. What are some of the other issues that I haven't asked you about today that maybe I've forgotten to, that you think are really important for Christians to be paying close attention to right now in the world or our country or even within the church?

# **GUEST: ALEX NEWMAN:**

Well, one that's really significant that I've been keeping track of for many years is the UN assault on educational liberty and parental rights, and that just culminated a couple of weeks ago, David, with a new report from the UN, from UNESCO, literally prepared under the supervision of a North Korean communist as acknowledged on the acknowledgments page, claiming that to uphold human rights, to comply with UN and international human rights law, all governments have an obligation to either ban home-schooling or at least bring it completely under government control to the point where they will control what they describe in the report as the education content, where they will do mandatory home visits, where they will determine what values are taught in the home school. And they also claim very openly by the way that private schools must be brought into this control. So they're now at the point where they're openly targeting our rights and responsibilities as parents that by the way, God imposed on us, these are not things that governments can legitimately infringe upon.

God placed the responsibility for educating, rearing, overseeing the development and upbringing of children on parents, not the state, but if you read the report, they say the state is the primary duty bearer when it

comes to education, and that's simply not true. We as Christians know that. So this effort to kick parents out of the picture, to seize control of the hearts and minds of the next generation is now completely out of the closet. The mask has dropped, and I regard this as an existential threat to family, to educational liberty and Christian education, and ultimately to civilization itself. So that's one of the many things I've been following.

As you mentioned, I'll be headed to Brazil just a couple days for the UN Climate Summit. They're using this climate hoax to fundamentally restructure human society, and actually to be blunt, they're using it to build a global, political, economic, and even religious system that is a direct attack on biblical principles, on the truth of scripture, that is a direct attack on national sovereignty, individual liberty, and all of these things are very, very serious threats. I would just urge parents and Christians and everybody to really begin paying attention here. These are significant threats, and we have to be aware, and I believe we have to take responsible action as Christians in line with what scripture teaches to do the right thing here.

### **HOST: DAVID WHEATON:**

Well, speaking of education, because that's what you brought up there about home education, Christian education, Megan Basham, who was the author of the book, Shepherds for Sale, she's a Christian. She posted recently, quote, "The head of the counseling department at Biola University," Bible Institute of Los Angeles, Biola, "one of the largest evangelical colleges in the country, has declared herself," this is the head of the counseling department there, "an LGBTQ ally, and this woman filed an amicus brief, a friend of the court brief in favor of Colorado's so-called conversion therapy ban." So Colorado is doing a ban on what they call conversion therapy that's trying to persuade someone through counseling to not be a homosexual anymore or not be transgender anymore.

She describes it as, "This ban prevents Christian counselors from using biblical teaching to help clients with unwanted LGBTQ behavior and identities. The real story," she says, "is that the drift and compromise Christian critics are highlighting at Biola is happening all across Christian higher education landscape even in more extreme ways than this. We need to talk about how Christian educational institutions are being infiltrated by people who are not Christian." Now, you have spent so much time in your life on education and I think mostly in primary and secondary education, even the public school in that realm, this has to do with Christian higher education. What is your response to this post by Megan Basham about what's going on at Biola and many other Christian colleges across the country?

#### **GUEST: ALEX NEWMAN:**

Unfortunately, it is a very, very serious threat. It's not new. If you go back and you read the New Testament, we were warned repeatedly about false teachers and wolves coming in among the flock. So this is not a new problem. For 2,000 years, the enemy has been trying to infiltrate the church, trying to infiltrate congregations, trying to infiltrate Christian institutions, and so that's not new. But what we're witnessing here is really breathtaking, David, this effort to undermine Christian counseling, and we're seeing this pop up across the country, the ban on so-called conversion therapy. I just want people to really understand this is an effort to criminalize the gospel. They want to prohibit us from sharing the truth of Jesus Christ with people that He can give us new desires, that He'll give us a heart of flesh and replace our heart of stone, that He can make us a new creation, that we are not defined by our sin. Our sin is not our identity.

Those things are very rapidly becoming a criminal offense in the context of these conversion therapy bans. We're seeing it across Europe. We've seen European governments claim that the Bible itself is hate speech. We just saw a cabinet minister in Canada claim that the Bible is hate speech. We need to be really careful, folks. I think Americans have this naive idea that we're immune to that because we have the First Amendment. Well, we're watching it happen, and worse, we're watching support from this coming from, as you just explained, David, as Megan just explained from within Christian institutions themselves. So we have an urgent matter that needs to be addressed here, and I think Christian institutions need to take urgent and immediate steps to protect themselves from this kind of infiltration.

# **HOST: DAVID WHEATON:**

Well, Alex, we just want to thank you for coming on the Christian Worldview radio program today. You're always generous with your time. We so appreciate your biblical insight on things going on within our own country, the church, world events. We are looking forward to your new book, Woke and Weaponized: how Karl Marx won the Battle for American Education, and How We Can Win it Back, coming out in January 2026. We'll look forward to having you back on for that. But in the meantime, thank you again and wishing all of God's best and grace to you and your family and all the work you're doing.

Well, we have a link to Alex Newman and his work at Liberty Sentinel Media at TheChristianWorldview.org. As you can see, Alex is very well-informed and has a sharp biblical worldview. It's important as we discuss the world domination mission of Islam, that we maintain two truths that aren't contradictory. Number one, every Muslim is made in the image of God with an eternal soul as valuable as yours and mine. Any given Muslim is the mission field, not the enemy. The second truth is this, that Christians should expect their leaders to uphold our constitution and values and not allow us to be taken over by Muslims. We don't need to emphasize one without the other, because Islam like every other false religion, Hinduism, Buddhism, Judaism, Mormonism, even Roman Catholicism, these do not adhere to the Gospel of Grace. That sinful man can be reconciled to God, not through man earning it, but through Christ earning our forgiveness and righteousness.

Anything other than the Gospel of Grace is a counterfeit of Satan, and he loves to use false religion to keep people from believing what Ephesians chapter two clearly says, "For by grace, you have been saved through faith and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God, not as a result of works so that no one may boast." So if you are trusting in your own works or anything other than Jesus Christ and His work for you on the cross alone, I urge you to obey Christ, to repent and believe in the biblical Gospel of Grace.
